#### **Happy New Year**

It has been lovely to welcome the children back to school this week. I hope that you all managed to relax at some time over the break. I know that in many families Christmas Day had to be 'moved' so that you could celebrate together when periods of isolation came to an end. As difficult as this must have been, when I reflect on where we were this time last year, I feel that we are in a much better situation than we were this time last year. We would once again remind you that although the Gateway is used by school to send messages and texts **it is not monitored for school to receive texts**. Please either email or phone with your queries, messages or replies.

#### **Breakfast and Afternoon Clubs**

Our Breakfast Club operates every day from 7:45am. The cost is £4 or £6 with breakfast including a selection of cereal and toast. With our L8R afternoon club you can book your child in to 4:30pm for £5 or to 5:30pm for £10. You can book whole weeks, regular days or occasional days as and when needed.

Each club does have a maximum capacity so early booking is recommended. You can book your child onto the clubs via the School Gateway. Please note, for staff planning purposes you need to make your bookings at least seven days in advance. Should circumstances change you can also cancel your booking up to seven days in advance. After seven days please call the office if you need to make an emergency cancellation. If your child simply does not show up you will still be charged.
